As Head of the Open Access Team at Nord University, I am wondering whether you allow self-archiving of conference proceedings in institutional repositories?
Some of our researchers published 'Opportunities and limitations in use of simulators in driver training in Norway. A qualitative study' in Proceedings of the 29th European Safety and Reliability Conference(ESREL). 22 – 26 September 2019 Hannover, Germany. As a general rule, our researchers are required to deposit their publications in our open, institutional repository, and most publishers allow at least self-archiving of either accepted manuscripts versions (postprints) or the published version. If you allow self-archiving, do you have any embargos?
